Dr Pozzi has been conducting clinical research to validate cutting edge digital technologies, novel implant design, and minimally invasive immediate implant rehabilitation concepts.

Dr. Berglundh is Professor at the Department of Periodontology and Head of the Periodontal Research Laboratory at University of Gothenburg. He is Associate Editor of Clinical Oral Implants Research and Journal of Clinical Periodontology and the textbook Clinical Periodontology and Implant Dentistry. Dr. Berglundh has produced more than 170 scientific publications within the field of dental implants, periodontology, immunology, genetics, tissue integration and regeneration.

Interactions between periodontitis and peri-implantitis represent one of the major fields of research and include translational systems of combinations of molecular biology techniques, experimental models and clinical trials.
